Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Well it seems like I just sent out our prayer letter and now I'm at it again. The truth is I did get a late start on the last letter but God has kept us very busy in January and February. We drove over 8,000 miles while presenting in 15 different churches which included 26 days of Mission Conference's. It's truly a blessing to be able to spend extra time with people of the churches we present at getting to know them and letting them get to know us better. Some days are tiring, especially for Alana as she works to keep up with her school work while traveling, but God knows when to refresh us. We picked up 4 supporting churches over the past two months and we were able to spend 5 days attending a mission conference in Chicago near where I grew up. During that time, God dumped snow on us almost every day we were there and we really enjoyed playing in it.

Each time I call a pastor to ask for the opportunity to present our burden, I tell them we want to come even if they can't support us. I explain that if God opens the door for us to be there, He always has something there for us. Financial support, prayer support, connections to others or churches that can support us, important lessons or some combination of those things are found everywhere we go. These past two months have been full of examples most would call coincidence but we see God at work.

Our first mission conference this year was in a church in Louisiana whose pastor we met at a church in Mississippi. The church in Mississippi didn't take us on for support but the church in Louisiana did. The entire pulpit and baptistry area was painted to remind us of why local and worldwide missions are so important. We ended February in a church whose pastor, while stationed in Germany as a young man in the Air Force, got saved at a church planted by missionaries to the US military in Germany. He told me when I booked the meeting they wouldn't be able to support us. But God worked a building fund miracle for them and they voted to take us on for support that day. We are now supported by a church whose pastor, like myself, is a product of what God has called us to go and do.



Please continue to pray for safety and traveling mercies as well as meetings and support. God has been very good to us and I thank you all for your part in those blessings. Also, please pray for our military and their families. We continue to meet people everywhere we go who tell us of the great need they and others they know face every day in the military. Our military, their families and supporters are truly under spiritual attack.
