Dear Friends,

It's hard to believe how fast time is flying by as we inch closer to leaving in November. We are still trying to decide on a date but it's looking more and more like November 15th or 16th. We have our passports in hand and are now looking at airline tickets. We are also looking at a cargo container. During the past few years, we have sold most of our household stuff but we still have some personal items like books and photos. The company we are talking with has given us a price on a 20 foot cargo container which is way more than we need so we are waiting to hear back from them on a price on a 'less than container' load. If the price is not too much different, we have been asked to take some Bibles and John/Romans with us when we pack it.

The airline tickets will cost us up to \$5,000 and the cargo container will cost us up to \$10,000. We are trying to lower that some and we are praying for God's help but I would like to ask each church reading this prayer letter to pray about helping us with those expenses. As the saying goes, many hands make light work.

Over the course of deputation, we have at times, noticed a little something off about our daughter Alana. We often just put it down as too much time in the car, too much time being together as a family and a new baby brother. However, we learned what the actual problem was just a couple weeks ago. Alana was invited to attend a church camp put on by one of our supporting churches in Kansas and our schedule allowed her to go. During the week that she was there, she asked Christ to forgive her of her sins and was saved! Deputation has had its difficult times but Alana's salvation was definitely not one of them and might not have been possible without deputation.

Finally, would you pray for Sheila and I as we work to visit a husband and family near our home church. The Sunday School teacher who took over my 4 year old boys class when we started deputation has a child whose father is an atheist. He is allowing his son to come to church and has started asking questions himself. We were asked to visit him because I grew up as an atheist and have a background similar to his. However, because of his schedule as an oil platform worker and our schedule with deputation travel, it has been hard to get together. Please pray for an open door and a receptive heart. This is very personal to me because of the way God loved me when I hated Him.
