We drove over 5,000 miles, presented in 13 different churches and dropped into 6 others for visits. Those drop-ins turned into 2 more meetings. One new church took us on and one of our supporting churches raised the amount they were supporting us for which puts us just short of having 10% support. The pace is slower than I'd like but each day we learn a little more how to live by faith. Each month what we have coming in is less than what we have going out yet God always meets our needs and more.

Last month, Sheila had a terrible toothache. The dentist took 4 x-rays and spent 4 hours trying to save the tooth before deciding it had to be pulled. She knew we were missionaries with no insurance so she didn't charge us a single dime! The oral surgeon who pulled the tooth told us it would cost around \$350.00. However, we still had a bill credit from when we had insurance so our cost was only \$30.00. God knows our needs way before we get to them and already has in place what we will need.

When we began deputation, I looked into getting a minivan because the space in our car is so tight when we load up for long trips. God said no because He was trying to teach me to be happy with what we already had. Our car is paid for and at almost 120,000 miles, it still runs well. At a church in Florida, the Pastor talked about how tight the back seat looked for my daughter with all our stuff loaded. We talked a bit about roof top and hitch carriers for more space but it felt like just friendly conversation. After I preached the church gifted us with a special offering to get the hitch carrier you see in the picture.



Everywhere we go, the Lord lets us meet people who have served, know someone who is serving or will be serving soon in Germany. We even got to witness to a Dollar General manager who was from Germany. The fields are white unto harvest and Christ prayed himself that God would send laborers. Please pray for us as we travel. For safety, support and meetings, but most importantly for the souls of those who have not yet trusted in Christ as their Saviour that God brings us into contact with daily.
