Well it's been another busy two months and God has continued to shower us with His blessings. After presenting in 20 churches the past two months we are now at 30% of our needed support and that amount continues to grow as churches continue to partner with us. November 3rd, after I vote, I head out on my final trip of the year. I'll be coming home on the 17th and have nothing scheduled until next year so we can spend the holidays together as a family with the new baby. Sheila and Alana already have a "Baby's First Christmas" ornament picked out for the tree.

In late September, I was asked to preach my first Mission's Conference. I would like to thank Bethany Baptist Church of Ava, MO and Pastor Robert Sorensen for the opportunity and blessing. On the last Wednesday of October, I was given the opportunity to present our burden to a pastor who supported the missionaries that planted the church in Germany where we were members. It was that church and those missionaries who planted the burden in us for what we are now doing. We are fruit of the mission field we are called to labor in but to be able to connect past with future was an amazing gift. God continues to shower little blessings like this upon us everywhere we go.

Mid September, Sheila was diagnosed with Gestational Diabetes and has been carefully watching her sugar levels. However, our son Michael, has grown faster than expected so the doctor has decided to induce labor before his December 1st due date. Michael is now scheduled to be fully with us on November 19, 2015.
